me thereunto moving I Mary Cowman of the county
aforesaid do hereby manumit and declare free agreeably
to the terms herein after specified to wit, my female slave
Louisa aged thutteen years or thereabouts and able to gain
a sufficient livelihood and maintainance and her the
said female slave Louisa I do hereby declare free manumitted
and discharged from slavery when she shall arrive at
the age of thirty three years which will be on the 12th
day of April eighteen hundred and twenty nine
and the issue of the aforesaid female born after
the date of these presents shall be free, I hereby
declaring and acknowledging the said negro Louisa
and her issue as aforesaid free and forever
discharged from all claim of service right or
property whatsoever from me my heirs executors
administrators or assigns from and after the
expiration of the time and after the date aforesaid
