Shaney of Ann Arundel County and State of Maryland  
for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto  
moving) as also in further consideration of  
five Shillings current money to me in hand paid  
have released from slavery liberated manumitted  
and set free and by these presents do hereby  
release from slavery liberate manumit and set  
free my negro boy named Calbut being  
eleven years old, the said negro boy Charles  
Calbut to be free on the eleventh day of  
September in the year of one thousand  
eight hundred and twenty nine being  
twenty years from the date hereof, I do  
declare to be free manumitted and  
from all manner of service to me my
