do grant bargain sell and deliver to the said negro adam
his time of service from the date hereof and will warrant
and defend the same to the said negro adam against
me my executors and administrators and against
every other person or persons whomsoever, In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my name and affixed my
seal this first day of December 1809.
