To whom it may concern be it known that I Jamima Duwall of Anne Arundel county in the state of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereto moving do release from slavery liberate manumit and set free after the last day of January eighteen hundred and ten and by these presents do (at the time above specified) release from slavery liberate manumit and set free my negro man named Daniel being about forty years old and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro man named Daniel I do declare to be after the last day of January eighteen hundred and ten manumitted and discharged from all manner of service or service to me my executors administrators or any other person or persons claiming under me; - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 4th day of December in the year of our Lord 1809.
