Anne Arundel county towit, To all whom it may concern be it known that I Mary Myrell of the county aforesaid being fully persuaded that all men are born free and equally entitled to the enjoyment of their liberty do hereby by these presents emancipate and set free from me my heirs executors and administrators the following slaves towit, negro Orange to serve ten years from the date of these presents also negro woman Elvinty to serve eleven years from the date of these presents and if she should have issue during her servitude if a boy or boy they to serve until they shall arrive to the aged of twenty five years, if a girl or girls to serve to the age
