To all whom it doth or may concern, be it known that I John Joice of
Anne Arundel county and state of Maryland for divers good causes and
considerations me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of one
dollar current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery
liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release
from slavery liberate manumit and set free my negro woman named
Pall Joice being of the age of fifteen years and able to gain
a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and her the said
negro woman named Pall Joice I do declare to be henceforth
free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude
or service to me my executors or administrators forever,
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this twenty fourth day of April
eighteen hundred and ten
