I Joshua Toogood of Anne Arundel County and
State of Maryland for divers good causes and
considerations and thereto moving as also the
further consideration of Ten dollars to me in
hand paid have released from Slavery liberated
unmolested and set free my negro man named
Ellick aged about nineteen years and my negro
man Josh aged twenty five years and my negro
girl Paul aged about twenty years and my
negro girl Rachel aged about sixteen years and
my negro girl named Prefs aged about ten
years and my negro woman Prefs aged about
fifty years and my negro girl named Sue
aged about twenty seven years and my negro
girl Kate aged about twenty three years all of
which negroes are able to work and gain a
sufficient livelihood and maintenance and him
the said negro man named Ellick and Josh
Paul, Rachel, Prefs and Old Prefs Sue and Kate
