To all whom it may concern Be it known that I Charles W. Dancy of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations and to wit (as also) in further consideration of one Dollar current money to me in hand paid have released from slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit and set free my negro man named Tom aged about thirty five years and my negro man named Isaac aged about thirty nine years the said negroes being able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and that the said negroes I hereby declare to be,
