To all whom it may concern Be it known
that I Susanna Franklin of Anne Arundel County
and State of Maryland for divers good causes and
considerations me thence moving, as also in further
consideration of five dollars current money to me in
hand paid have from and after the first day of
November in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight and twenty eight released from slavery
liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents
from and after the time aforesaid do hereby release
from slavery, liberate manumit and set free my
negro boy named Nicholas being of the age of nine
years and able to work and gain a sufficient
livelihood and maintenance and him the said negro
boy,
