To all whom it may concern Be it known that I Anne Jimes of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations me thereunto moving as also in further consideration of the sum of five dollars current money to me in hand paid do and have released from ^{liberated} slavery the manumitted and set free and by these presents do release from slavery librate manumitted and set free my negro man Charles, also my negro man Daniel also my negro woman Dinah the said negroes Charles, Daniel and Dinah I do declare from the date of these presents to be free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my Executors or administrators forever.
