This Indenture Witnesseth that I Rachel  
maria Harrison of Anne Arundel County and State  
of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum  
of one Cent to me in hand paid at and before  
the sealing and delivery of these presents the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
released from slavery manumitted and set free  
and by these presents do manumit and set free  
and release from slavery my negro girl named  
Susan which said negro being under the age of  
forty five years of healthy constitution sound in  
mind and body and capable by labour to procure  
to herself sufficient food and raiment with other  
requisite necessaries of life from and after the  
first day of January Eighteen hundred and forty  
nine,
