This Invention Witnesseth that I Rachel Maria Harrison of Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five pounds at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have released from slavery committed and set free and by these presents do release from slavery manumitted and do set free my negro woman ~~named~~ which said negro being under the age of forty five years of healthy constitution sound mind and body and capable by labour to procure to herself sufficient food and raiment with other requisite necessaries of life from and after the first day of January in the year Eighteen hundred and thirty nine.
