 and being) thereunto moved and release) manumitted
 and set free my negro boy named Bill Hall
 aged nine years and six months and my negro
 girl Look Hall aged six years and six
 months each of said negroes being) sound limb
 and apparently likely to be able to get and sufficient
 maintenance the said Bill Hall after he has
 served till he is twenty eight years of age and
 said girl Look Hall after serving till she is
 twenty five years of age) shall be free from all
 slavery and if said girl Look should have any
 wound or hurt of her body) byotten I do hereby certify) grant
 and agree if said girl Look should be twenty) one years of
 age and then be free from all slavery if female
 should serve until the age of sixteen years and
 then be free from all slavery whereof I do hereby
 acknowledge this to be my act and deed this
 eighth day of August in the year of our
 Lord
