To all whom it may concern I do know that
I Pracey Tackey of Anne Arundel County in the State
of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
me thereunto moving as also in further consideration
of the sum of five shillings current money to me in
hand paid do hereby from and after the first
day of December which shall arrive after the
day of my intermarriage with any person
whatsoever, release from slavery liberate manumit
and set free my negro man named Green
being of the age of twenty four years and able
to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and
maintenance, and thus the said negro man named
Green,
