

I know all men by these presents that I Richard Mullin of Anne Arundel County and the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to me in hand paid by Susanna Mullin of the same State and County have manumitted liberated and discharged from slavery and by these presents do manumit liberate and discharge from slavery the following negroes to wit Susanna Mullin, Eliza Mullin aged seven years, Hagar Mullin aged three years, Priscilla Mullin aged two years and all the issue of the said Susanna Mullin, which said Susanna Mullin I purchased of James Deal of Anne Arundel County, and I the said Richard Mullin do hereby declare the said negroes to be absolutely free removed and discharged from all claims of slavery of me and my heirs Executors and administrators forever. In Witness whereof I the said Richard Mullin have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty second day of October eight hundred and nineteen.

On this twenty second day of October eight hundred and nineteen before the subscribed a Justice of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for the County aforesaid appeared the above named Richard Mullin and acknowledged the foregoing instrument of writing as and for his act and deed and the above named Susanna Mullin, Eliza Mullin Hagar Mullin and Priscilla Mullin to be absolutely free and discharged from all claims of servitude to him his heirs Executors and administrators
