 Richard G. Stutter of Anne Arundelle County in the
 State of Maryland for divers good causes and
 considerations me therunto moving have released from
 Slavery liberated manumitted and set free by their
 presents do hereby release from Slavery liberate
 manumitted and set free after a term of years my
 negroes Robert George aged twenty five years of age
 to be free on the first day of January in the year
 eighteen hundred and twenty seven; James aged
 twenty three years to be free on the first day of
 January in the year eighteen hundred and twenty
 seven; Little James aged twenty years to be free on
 the first day of January in the year eighteen and
 twenty six; William aged one year to be free on
 the first day of March in the year eighteen hundred
 and forty; Woman Nansey aged nineteen years
 to be free on the first day of January in the year
 eighteen hundred and twenty seven; and all the
 increase of the said Nansey born during the time
 of her servitude to serve if males twenty one
 years and if females eighteen years; Woman Mintie
 aged seventeen years to be free on the first day of
 January in the year eighteen hundred & twenty
 four; and all the increase of the said Mintie that
 born during the time of her servitude to serve
 if males to the age of twenty one years, and if
 females eighteen years, and the increase of the
 above women that born after their respective
 servitude is expired to be free to their latest
 generations
