To all whom it may concern Be it known that I
Daniel Ward of the City of Annapolis in the State
of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
me therein moving as also in further consideration
of the sum of five dollars in cash money to me hereunto
paid have released from slavery, liberated, manumitted
and set free and by these presents do here by release from
slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free my Negro
girl named Debba born about the age of twelve
years from and after the twenty fourth day of
February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty three she being able to work
and give a sufficient livelihood and maintenance
