 manumitted librated and set free, and do hereby
 manumit librate and set free from and after the
 first day of November in the year eighteen hundred
 thirty three my negro Boy Joe, being now about
 sixteen years old, and within the age allowed by
 Law, and able to earn a livelihood, and I do
 hereby for myself my heirs Executors and Administrators
 the said negro Boy Joe from and after the day above
 mentioned release and discharge of and from all
 service or servitude whatsoever, from that time forever
 In Witness whereof I have unto my hand and seal
 this twelfth day of November in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and thirteen
