 gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance
 and him the said negro man named Will I do
 declare to be henceforth free manumitted and
 discharged from all manner of servitude or
 service to me my Executors or administrators for
 ever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal this sixteenth day of
 December in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred
 and nineteen.
