 are to continue in servitude as aforesaid shall be
 free and manumitted as they respectively arrive to the
 age of thirty one years and I do hereby warrant
 and further defend the freedom of the aforesaid
 negroes upon the terms aforesaid from all claims
 and demands legal and equitable of any person
 here and abroad and all persons claiming by
 from through or me and them. In Witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 on this thirteenth day of January Anno Domini one
 thousand eight hundred and seventeen.
