have released from slavery/manumitted and set free
and by these presents do release from slavery/
manumitted and set free the several following slaves
on the terms as hereafter mentioned my negro
woman named Sarah to be free at my death, my
negro man named Jacob aged 32 years to be free
after serving) two years, my negro Girl named
Rebecca aged sixteen years to serve until she
arrives to the age of thirty one years, my negro
boy named Perry aged eleven years to serve until
he arrives to the age of thirty five years, Bessie
aged eight years to serve until she arrives at the
age of thirty one years, Serena aged six years to
serve until she arrives at the age of thirty one
years, Henrietta aged two years to serve until
she arrives to the age of thirty one years, they being
