

To all whom it may concern: Be it known
 that I William Brewer of the City of Annapolis
 for divers good causes and considerations and thence
 moving as also in further consideration of five
 dollars current money some in hand paid have
 released from slavery liberated manumitted and set
 free and by these presents do hereby release from
 slavery liberated manumitted and set free on the first
 day of May eighteen hundred and thirty one my
 mulatto man named Watt being of the age of
 twenty years and able to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance, and I do also hereby
 release from slavery liberated manumitted and set free
 on the first day of May eighteen hundred and
 thirty one my negro man named George being
 of the age of twenty six years and able to work
 and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance
 the said mulatto man named Watt and the
 said negro man named George I declare before
 manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude or service to me my Executors or administrators
 at the expiration of the respective periods above
 mentioned and expressed in this and of manumission
 In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this 16th day of May eighteen
 hundred and thirty one.
