 said: Anne Amund County said: On this twenty
 second day of June personally appeared Eliza Clark
 party to the above instrument of writing before me
 Justice of the peace of the County aforesaid and of
 the State of Maryland and acknowledges the same
 to be her act and deed for the purposes above
 mentioned and the Negro woman above mentioned
 to be her lawful manumitted and discharged
 from all service to her or any claiming under her
 and to be free & unmanumitted according to the act
 of the General Assembly in such cases made and provided.

This Indenture Witnesseth That I Clement
 Davis of Anne Amund County in the State of
 Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one
 dollar to me in hand paid at and before the making
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have released from slavery
 manumitted and set free and by these presents do
 release from slavery manumitted and set free my
 woman slave named Betty now in my possession.

 and affixed my seal this first day of July 1820
 hundred and twenty.
