 the age of thirty years of age and the female until  
 they arrive to the age of twenty five years of age  
 and no longer In Testimony whereof I have  
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this  
 sixteenth day of December in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and twenty
