 mentioned Negroes take free from all manner of
 servitude or claim whatsoever from us our heirs
 Executors or administrators forever. In Testimony
 whereof we have hereunto set our hands and
 affixed our seals this twentieth day of August
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty.
