To all whom it may Concern Be it known that I Mary Mendenhall of the County of Anne Arundel in the State of Maryland for divers good causes ~~and~~ do hereby release from slavery the said manumitted and set free three negroes to wit my negro woman Charity on the first day of January eighteen hundred and twenty seven, my negro girl Peggy on the first day of January eighteen hundred and forty five, also my negro boy Henry on the first day of January eighteen hundred and forty nine with all the children the above named negro woman Charity may hereafter have when she makes shall arrive at the full age of thirty years, and the females at the full age of twenty eight years. I do declare the above named negroes at the expiration of the respective terms above mentioned to be set free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or duties to me my Executors or Administrators forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twelfth day of January in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty one.
