being of the age of thirty eight years and able to
work and gain a sufficient livelihood maintenance
and him the said negro man named Samson I do
declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged
from all manner of servitude or service to me my
executors or administrators forever. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal this tenth day of March in the year of our
Lord 1821.

and manumitted according to the Act of Assembly
in such cases made and provided.
