 I Eliza Hammond of said county in the State
 of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations
 and to wit money, as also in further Consolation
 of fine dollars Current money to me in hand paid have
 released from Slavery liberated manumitted and set
 free and by these presents do hereby release from
 Slavery liberate manumitted and set free, my negro
 man named Nicholas Scott being of the age of thirty
 five years, and able to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance and here the said negro
 man named Nicholas Scott I do declare to be here forth
 free manumitted and discharged, from all manner
 of servitude or service to me my Executors or Administrators
 forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day
 of March in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty
 one.
