3. Recorded the 15th day of March 1821.

This Indenture made this fourth day of
march eighteen hundred & twenty one between
Thos. Mary Shipley of said Anne Arundel County State
of Maryland in consideration of the sum of one hundred
dollars in hand paid before the making of the same
of the presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge
have manumitted & set free and do by these presents
manumit & set free and release from slavery
my negro girl called now aged seventeen to
serve until she arrives to the age of twenty one
years, she being of a healthy Constitution and
Capable by labor to provide for herself the
necessaries of life, and I also manumit and set
free as above, my negro boy Daniel he being now
five years old to serve until he is thirty years old,
as well as Sarah Ann now five days old to serve
until she is thirty years old & should she and
Sarah Ann have children during that time of her
servitude they are also to be free at thirty. In
Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& seal.
