

and twenty seven; also my negro man named Robert who is now about the age of eighteen years who is to receive his freedom on the first day of October eight hundred and twenty seven; also my negro boy named Ravadae who is now about the age of seven years who is to receive his freedom on the first day of October in the year eight hundred and thirty three; and also my negro girl named Mary being about the age of thirteen years who together with all her increase is to receive her freedom on the first day of October in the year of our Lord eight hundred and twenty four and thus the said negroes as above named I do declare to be from the respective periods above mentioned free manumitted and discharged from all manner of servitude or service to me my Executors or administrators forever. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixth day of March in the year of our Lord eight hundred and twenty one.
