Be it remembered, That on this twenty fifth day of July 1821 personally appears George Wells party to the within instrument of writing before me the Subscribed a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland for the said County and acknowledges the same to be his act and deed for the purposes within mentioned and the negro man within named to be himself manumitted and discharged from all services to him or to any claiming under him, and to be free and manumitted according to the act of assembly in such cases made and provided.

To all whom it may concern Be it known That I William Bishop of the City of Annapolis in and for Anne Arundel County State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and twenty one dollars and no part thereof to me in hand paid have released from Slavery manumitted and set free and by these presents
