 That I Benjamin Sunderland of the County of Anne Arundel
 County in the State of Maryland for divers good
 causes and considerations me therefore moving
 as also in further consideration of one Dollar
 current money to me in hand paid, have released
 from slavery liberated manumitted and ^{set} free
 and by these presents do hereby release from slavery
 liberate manumitted and ^{set} free my negro man
 Isaac Henson being of the age of forty four
 years, and able to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance and him the said
 negro man named Isaac Henson I do declare to
 be henceforth free manumitted and discharged
 from all manner of servitude or service to me
 my Executors or administrators forever. In
 Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this twenty fourth day
 month in the year of our Lord Eight hundred
 and twenty one.
