came annuall County Court: On this County Court any of our persons personally appears Benjamin Sunderland freely told within mentioned Court before me the subscribed a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland for the said County and acknowledges the same told his act and deed for the purposes within mentioned; and the negro man within named told hereforth manumitted and discharged from all services to him or any claiming under him and told free and manumitted according told act of assembly in such cases made and said provided. Acknowledged before Rezin Estep

This Indenture Witnesseth that whereas it appears from papers in the hand writing of the late John Galloway of Tulip Hill that he heretofore did free his negro slave Maria Boston, being under forty five years of age, of a healthy constitution sound in mind and body and capable by labour to procure told sufficient food and raiment with other requisite necessaries of life together with her issue and whereas sufficient evidence does not appear, or is lost, to substantiate the above facts now to leave no doubt with respect to the freedom of said Maria and her children, Sarah Galloway and Virgin Mary of Tulip Hill in and annuall County and State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of One Cent to them in hand paid before the sealing and delivery,
