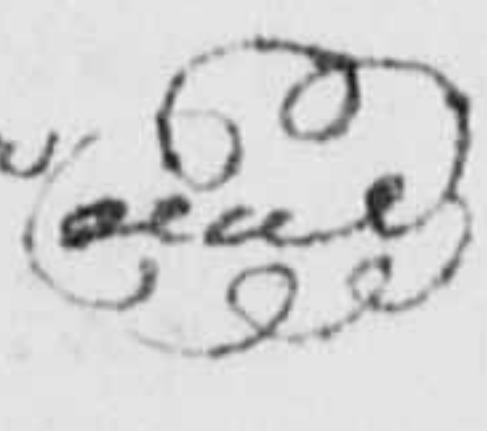


being released from slavery liberte manumitted and

 gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance and
 she the said mulatto woman named Rebecca I do
 declare to be here forth free manumitted and
 discharged from all manner of servitude or service
 to me my Executors or administrators forever. In
 Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this twenty second day of
 October in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty one.

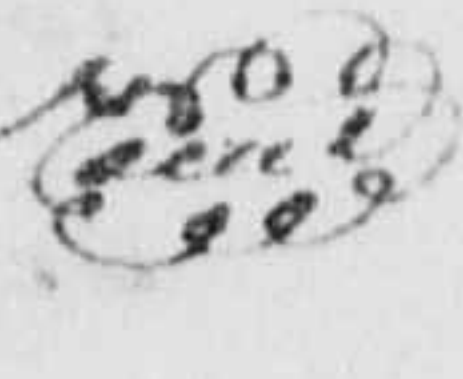

 day of October 1821 personally appeared Robert Warfield
 Junr party to the within instrument of writing before me
 the undersigned a Justice of the peace of the State of
 Maryland for the said County and acknowledged
 the same to be his act and deed for the purposes within
 mentioned and the mulatto woman within named
 to be here forth manumitted and discharged from
 all service to him or to any claiming under him
 and to be free and manumitted according to the act
 of assembly in such cases made and provided.
