Personally appears John Forty party to the within  
instrument appearing before me the subscriber a  
Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland for the  
County aforesaid and acknowledges the same to  
be his act and deed for the purposes within  
mentioned and the Negro woman within named  
to be lawfully manumitted and discharged from  
all services to him or to any claiming under him  
and to be free and unmanumitted according to the  
act of assembly in such cases made and provided.

Recorded the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817.

Know all men by these presents that I Charles  
Carroll of Carrollton of the City of Annapolis in the  
State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations  
me therein money have released from Slavery liberated  
manumitted and set free & by these presents do hereby  
release from Slavery liberate manumitted and set free  
from & after the several & respective dates & periods  
herein after respectively appointed & prescribed all &  
singular the Negro Slaves male and female herein  
after,
