O To all whom it may concern both known that I
Nathaniel Ridgely (widow of Henry Ridgely late of Anne
Arundel County deceased) of the City of Annapolis in the
County aforesaid in the State of Maryland for divers good
causes and considerations me therunto moving as also
in further consideration of the sum of one thousand money
of the United States to me in hand paid released from
slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these
presents do hereby release from slavery liberate manumit
and set free my mulatto woman named Nan or Nancy
being of the age of about thirty five years and also the
daughter of the said Nan or mulatto called Ann Nancy
being of the age of seven years both of which said slaves
are able to work & gain a sufficient livelihood &
maintenance and her the said mulatto woman & her
said daughter I do hereby declare to be henceforth free &
manumitted and discharged from all manner of
servitude or service to me my executors or administrators
(Forever)
