To all whom it may Concern be it known that I Herms
 H Bates of Anne Arundel County in the State of Maryland
 for divers good Causes and Considerations me therunto
 moving as also in further Consideration of Five Dollars
 Current money to me in hand paid have released from
 Slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these
 presents do hereby release from Slavery liberate manumitt
 and set free the following negroes whenever they shall
 have severally served me the term of years as is herein
 after specified to wit One negro man named Benjamin
 Brown aged twenty one years to serve until he shall
 have arrived to the age of twenty six years. one negro
 man named Stephen Stewart aged twenty years to
 serve until he shall have arrived to the age of twenty
 six years. one negro boy named Henry Rawlings aged
 eleven years to serve until he shall have arrived to
 the age of Twenty six years. one negro girl named
 Lemmy
