 at their respective ages of thirty five years and I do
 by these presents declare the said negro Slaves
 male & female herein before mentioned, and all &
 singular the said issue of the said female Slaves
 to be free unincumbered & discharged from all manner
 of servitude or service to me my Executors or
 administrators from and after the several and
 respective dates periods and ages herein before
 respectively assigned & prescribed for ever. In
 Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 & affixed my seal this Eighteenth day of December
 in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & sixteen.
