Know all men by these presents that I Gideon Warts of
 the City of Annapolis for diverse good Causes me therunto
 moving as also the sum of Ten dollars to me in hand paid
 have released from Slavery manumitted and set free
 and by these presents do hereby release manumitted and set
 free my two molatto girls bought of James O'Rourke
 on the 12th day of April 1823 on the following terms to wit
 Betty or Betty aged seven years to be free at the age of
 Twenty five years Nancy aged three years to be free at
 the age of Twenty five years and the issue of the said
 Betty and Nancy and their issue forever to be free at
 the age of Twenty five years and do hereby declare the
 said Betty and Nancy to be free from me and my
 heirs administrators and assigns forever on the above
 (Condition)
