This Indenture witnesseth that I Nicholas
 Warfield of the County of Anne Arundel County of State of
 Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of one
 dollar to me in hand paid at and before the executing
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have released from slavery
 manumitted and set free and by these presents do
 release from slavery manumitted and set free my
 negro boy William at the age of thirty one years
 he being fifteen years of age the twelfth day of
 June
