To all whom it may Concern be it known that I Gerard Hobbs
 of Ann Arundel County in the State of Maryland for divers good
 Causes and Considerations mo^therunto moving as also in further
 Consideration of one dollar Current money to me in hand paid
 the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge has released from
 Slavery liberated manumitted and set free and by these presents
 do hereby release from Slavery liberate manumitted and set free
 my negro woman named Mary being of the age of thirty years
 with her Child named Leahy being of the age of two years
 tho the said Mary being able to work and gain a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance for herself and Child Leahy
 and let the said negro woman Mary & Child named Leahy
 I do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged
 from all manner of servitude or service to me my executors
