to be free & manumitted according to the act of assembly in
such cases made and provided

To all whom it may Concern be it known that I Sarah
Harris of Armed Amos County in the State of Maryland for
divers good Causes and Considerations (and therunto moving
Laws and rules release from slavery liberated manumitted
and set free and by these presents do hereby release from
slavery liberated manumitted and set free my negroes to wit
James Dennis aged twenty two years to be free the 5th day of
April one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven Maria
aged twenty years to be free the 13th day of February one
thousand eight hundred and twenty three John aged
eighteen years to be free the first day of August one
