I know all men by these presents that I Elizabeth Hood of said Anne Arundel County and State of Maryland for divers good causes and considerations hereunto moving, and the further sum of four dollars current money well truly and by these presents well received & cleared and set free from slavery my negro man & Nicholas from and after the term of twelve years from this date. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seventeen.
