To all whom it may Concern be it known that I George
 McKier of the City of Annapolis in Anne Arundel County
 and State of Maryland for divers good causes and
 Considerations me therunto moving as also the further
 Consideration of five dollars to me in hand paid have
 released from Slavery liberated manumitted and set
 free and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery
 manumitted and set free my negro Girl Margaret being
 of the age of thirteen years on the following terms to wit
 to be free on the twenty fourth day of March one thousand
 eight hundred and forty one at which time she will be
 thirty years of age and the free of the said Margaret
 both male and female to be free at the age of twenty five
 years and the free of the said female free to be free at
 the age of twenty five and the free of the said free to be
 free at twenty five years of age and so on forever and
 the said negro girl Margaret I do declare to be free
 manumitted and discharged from all manner of
 servitude to me my heirs and assigns forever on the
