 presents do hereby release from Slavery manumitted and  
 do free my negro woman viz<sup>d</sup> Harriet being of the age  
 of twenty four years to be free from and after the first day  
 of April eighteen hundred and twenty four being one year  
 and three months from the date of these presents. and my  
 negro girl Charlotte being of the age of fifteen years to be free  
 from and after the first day of April eighteen hundred and  
 thirty being five years and three months from the date of  
 these presents both of which said Slaves are able to work  
 and gain a sufficient livelihood and then the said  
 Harriet and Charlotte I do declare each to be free  
 manumitted. and discharged from all manner of servitude  
 or service to me my executors or administrators forever from  
 and after the period herein before mentioned which each has  
 to serve. In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand and affixed my seal this twenty ninth day of  
 December eighteen hundred and twenty four
