

Know all men by these presents that I James Anderson of Anne Arundale County and State of Maryland for divers good Causes and Considerations me therunto moving as also for the sum of one dollar do hereby do free manumit and liberate my negro man Jacob aged about forty four years immediately on my decease and by these presents do declare and release from slavery on my decease the said slave Jacob who is in the hire and employ of James McCulloch of Baltimore County and for the safety and security that the said Jacob shall not remain in slavery longer than my decease I hereby enjoin and require of my executors or any other or all persons claiming under me to procure to the said Jacob his freedom and to defend the same against all persons claiming or to claim. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty four
