 my death declare to be lawfully free manumitted
 and discharged from all manner of servitude or
 service to me my Executors or administrators they
 and their heirs forever. In Testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty
 seventh day of November in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and sixteen
