 girl Charia (daughter of Lydia when she shall arrive at the
 age of sixteen. Negro boy Isaac on the first day of January
 eighteen hundred and forty six. Negro Harriott on the first
 day of January eighteen hundred and forty nine Negro boy
 John on the first day of January eighteen hundred and fifty
 one. Negro Charitas on the first day of January eighteen
 hundred and fifty four all of whom at the respective
 periods above specified being able to procure a sufficient
 livelihood and maintenance the aforementioned negroes
 I do declare to be free manumitted and discharged as they
 respectively arrive at the periods above specified from all
 manner of servitude or service to me or any claiming under
 me forever In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
 hand and affixed my seal the eighth day of January one
 thousand eight hundred and twenty five
