To all whom these presents shall come greeting be it
known that I Edw. Parrier daughter of William
Parrier of Anne Arundel County Maryland and State of
Maryland for divers good Causes and Considerations me
thereunto moving have and by these presents do
manumit set free and liberate from Slavery a
negro boy by the name of Tuba when he said negro
I have drew at the age of thirty years. In testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
twenty first day of February 1823
