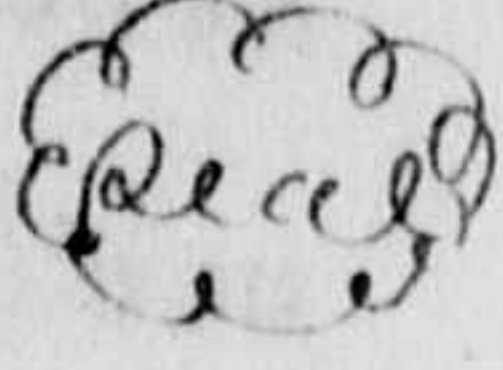

of the peace of the State of Maryland in and for Anne
Arundel County personally appears the above named
Charles Boone party to the above instrument of
writing and acknowledged the same to be his act
and deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned

To all whom it may concern be it known that I
George L. Brewer of the City of Annapolis in the State of
Maryland for divers good Causes and Considerations
me therunto moving as also in further Consideration
of one dollar Current money to me in hand paid have
released from Slavery liberated manumitted and set
free and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery
manumitted and set free my negro woman Harriett being
of the age of twenty six years to be free from and after the
twenty eighth day of November eighteen hundred and
twenty five which said Slave is able to work and gain
a sufficient livelihood and she the said Harriett I do
declare to be free manumitted and discharged from all
manner of servitude or service to me my executor or
